POSITION OVERVIEW: Lowell House Addiction Treatment and Recovery, a private, non-profit addiction treatment services agency is seeking a full-time, salaried recovery coach to join its Behavioral Health Community Partnership team. The Greater Lowell BH CP is a partnership with Lowell Community Health Center (lead agency).

Utilizing the Recovery Coaching Model, the Recovery Coach will provide peer recovery support services to individuals struggling with substance use who are enrolled in the BHCP. The Recovery Coach will facilitate connection to community resources, all levels of addiction treatment and recovery support, and any services required to achieve total wellness.

This job is ideal for anyone who is passionate about working with individuals with Substance Use Disorder and Co-Occurring Disorders and wants to work in a Mission focused agency with a relaxed, friendly, and supportive work culture. Supervision for Recovery Coaching certification is available.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Provide recovery coaching services to individuals enrolled in the Greater Lowell BHCP who are seeking peer recovery support.
- Collaborate with referral agencies, ACOs, and Community-based Organizations.
- Conduct outreach and engagement to eligible individuals and provide information about recovery coaching services.
- Provide recovery coaching services to enrollee's in a variety of settings (office, enrollee's homes, shelters, drop-in centers, and other locations).
- Assist member in navigating the network of community based services and information.
- Identify and address needs for interpreter services, cultural needs and preferences.
- Assist with transportation to needed medical/behavioral health appointments as needed.
- Complete all required documentation in a timely manner.
- Participate in supervision with supervisor as required.
- Participate in training as required.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- High school diploma.
- Valid driver's license with a reliable and appropriately insured vehicle.
- Completed Recovery Coach Academy and working towards Recovery Coach Certification.
- Must possess a thorough understanding of the Recovery Coaching Model and be able to apply this knowledge in different settings.
- Bilingual (Spanish/Khmer) is preferred.
- Basic computer skills.
